IRG-Rail Plenary Assembly held in Gdańsk

This year's first Plenary Assembly of Independent Regulators' Group – Rail was held in Gdańsk in Poland on the 27th and 28th of April. The goal of IRG-Rail is to strengthen cooperation among rail regulatory bodies and to provide them with an independent forum for the exchange of information and experience.
