Post-holiday timetable adjustment

01.09.2023

A planned post-holiday adjustment to the annual train timetable comes into force on Sunday 3 September 2023. Trains according to this timetable will run until 11 November this year.

During the 2022/2023 timetable, the infrastructure manager PKP Polskie Linie Kolejowe S.A. has scheduled four adjustments due to, i.a., renovation works on railway network. The next revision is still planned for 12 November 2023.

This timetable adjustment brings several significant changes. Due to the next stage of modernisation works on Kraków – Zakopane line, the latter will have a substitute bus service. Seasonal connections will stop. On 1 October 2023 the launch of a new railway line (junction) leading directly to the Jasionka Airport near Rzeszów (name of railway station: Jasionka Lotnisko) is planned.

Any changes to a timetable should be announced at least 21 days before their entry into force on the infrastructure manager's website. Passenger stations' managers are under obligation to publish a new timetable at least 10 days in advance to the introduction of a new timetable or timetable changes. Appropriate information should appear on posters or boards at train stations, platforms or passageways to platforms. The updated timetable should also be available on the rail carriers' websites, although the Polish law does not impose any specific publication dates.
